

Get Vulnerability Scan Details for a Report

Overview



This topic only applies to **Armor Anywhere** users.

The **Get Vulnerability Scan Details for a Report** API retrieves data for a specified report.



You can use the [Get Vulnerability Scans](#) API to find the **reportId** / **scanReportId**, which will return as **id**.



You can use this API to find the vulnerability ID (**vulnerabilityId**), which you will need for other vulnerability-related API calls. In this API, the vulnerability ID will return as **vulnerabilityId**.

```
